## **Purchase Order Terms and Conditions**

The following General Terms and Conditions (GTC) and Quality Requirements (QR) affect all Kryler Purchase Orders and Contracts, as applicable.

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GTC 1	<b>Right of Entry</b> The buyer and buyer's customer, and their customers, or any applicable agency will have the right to enter the seller's facility to perform inspection or ensure compliance to the contract.
GTC 2	Amendments to this purchase order, or Kryler's terms and conditions shall be set forth in writing, via
0102	purchase order change notice, and/or revisions to the purchase order terms and conditions. Kryler will
	consider seller's request to modification of, or exception to, only if such request is made in writing, prior
	to the acceptance of the order (ref: acceptance clause)
GTC 3	The supplier shall have in place a system/program that conforms to (as applicable):
GICU	Quality system / Program Requirements Calibration system
	MIL-I-45208, AS9100 or ISO-9001 ISO 10012-1 or ANSI Z 540-1
GTC 4	Shipment of goods and services under this order shall be f.o.b. as set forth on the purchase order. Seller
010.	shall follow buyer's instructions regarding method of shipment, except where buyer has so stated on the
	purchase order.
GTC 5	Schedule for delivery will be the responsibility of the seller. The seller shall not be held liable for
0100	damages in respect to delivery delay due to causes beyond seller's reasonable control. However, if the
	seller does not meet the delivery date as depicted on the purchase order, the buyer may approve a revised
	delivery schedule, or terminate the order without liability for such termination.
GTC 6	Hazardous Material Seller agrees to furnish the applicable Material Safety Data Sheet(s) (MSDS) with
	each shipment, for products designated by industry, state, or federal agencies as hazardous material.
GTC 7	Packaging and Protection of the product shipped shall be in accordance with Kryler's purchase order or
	best practice to protect product from damage and/or deterioration.
GTC 8	Cancellation shall remain the right of the buyer and may be initiated at any time.
GTC 9	Identification and Traceability shall be applied and maintained by seller for all product/material shipped
GIC)	under this purchase order/contract in accordance with the applicable material/process specification and
	sellers quality system.
GTC 10	All drawings accompanying the purchase order are proprietary and are not to be transferred to other
01010	parties without written authorization.
GTC 11	<b>Certification of Conformance</b> Each shipment shall be accompanied by a dated certification signed by a
01011	responsible representative of the supplier, stating that the items were processed in conformance with the
	purchase order requirements, engineering drawing, revision and specification requirements including as a
	minimum the supplier name, purchase order, number, part number, quantities accepted and rejected.
	Additional quality requirements apply when referenced on the purchase order.
GTC 12	Quality Assurance The supplier shall comply with the Kryler Corp. Quality System requirements as
	specified by the purchase order. Supplier agrees to implement and maintain the Quality and Inspection
	System during the performance of the contract. Suppliers shall furnish a complete Certification of
	Conformance with each shipment P.O.
GTC 13	The supplier is not authorized to perform Material Review action of nonconforming material.
GTC 14	The supplier shall notify Kryler when product is out of tolerance or in an unacceptable condition.
GTC 15	Where applicable, only <b>qualified/certified personnel</b> shall be used based on process specification
01010	requirements. Records shall be maintained of the personnel qualifications/certifications.
GTC 16	Nonconformances Upon acceptance of a Kryler purchase order, the supplier agrees that Kryler is entitled
01010	to reimbursement of Kryler labor and material costs associated with seller responsible nonconformances
	and damages.
GTC 17	Acceptance and Test Reports Include with each shipment a copy, signed by an authorized agent of the
	seller, with results of the lot or item acceptance tests required by the applicable specification. The report
	shall indicate the actual values obtained. Test reports shall include control identity (e.g. job number, lot,
	serial number, etc.) of material/item tested. Seller is required to maintain inspection and test records as
	required by contract/purchase order.
GTC 18	Age Control and Limited Life Products Seller records for control/ life limited products shall reflect
	useful life and when useful life will expire.
GTC 19	The supplier shall retain their records for a minimum of seven years, unless otherwise indicated
GTC 20	Supplier must flow down Kryler's Quality requirements to sub-tier contractors.
GTC 21	ITAR When required and so noted on the purchase order, the product shall be processed under the ITAR
31021	requirements.

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GTC 22	Boeing Approved Source:
	Any/All Boeing processes must be performed by Boeing Approved Sources per D1-4426.
	Processing shall be performed to the latest revision. This clause shall be included in the seller's
	subcontracts for work performed under this purchase contract that involves D1-4426 processes. The
	certificate shall include but not be limited to, part number, quantity, part name, precise identification,
	customer program, material, process specification number w/revision, processing date, and name and
	address of the processor performing each of the D1-4426 processes.
QR 1	The supplier shall perform and document a complete First Article Inspection Report (FAIR) including
	100 % of B/P or specification requirements. One copy of supplier FAIR will be furnished to Kryler along
	with the first shipment for this purchase order/contract.
QR 2	The supplier shall provide an <b>Inspection Report</b> (IR) identifying requirements and actuals. One copy of
	the IR shall be furnished to Kryler representing each lot.
QR 3	The supplier shall perform 100% inspection. A record of the inspection results shall be provided to
	Kryler, sampling inspection is not allowed.
QR 4	Government <b>Source Inspection</b> is required at supplier facility prior to shipment. Supplier shall contact
	Kryler and applicable Government Representative to arrange for Government acceptance prior to
	shipment from supplier facility.
QR 5	Physical or Chemical Analysis test reports which list actual chemical, mechanical values which state
	conformance to applicable material specifications shall be submitted on each shipment.
QR 6	Raw Material shall be accompanied with C of C's, chemical and / or physical test results. The seller shall
	certify to the specific requirements defined on the face of the purchase order. Each shipment shall be
	accompanied by a dated certification signed by a responsible representative of the supplier, stating that the
	items were produced from materials which the supplier has available for examination and objective
	evidence of conformance to the purchase order and applicable specification shall be listed, including the
	revision and date.
QR 7	Counterfeit Parts – Supplier shall prevent the use of counterfeit parts
QR 8	Ethical Behavior – Supplier shall ensure persons are aware of their contribution to product/service
	conformity, product safety and the importance of ethical behavior.
QR 9	Acceptance Authority Media (AAM) - Seller understands that the application of acceptance authority
	media (AAM) is a personal warranty of compliance and conformity and will establish appropriate controls
	for AAM (e.g., stamps, electronic signatures, passwords).

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
